G-9 Orals - A new idea

Students draw 4 errand cards (possibly 3). The cards say things like:

Du musst Geld aus der Automat kriegen Du musst Briefmarken kaufen Du willst Kaffee trinken

The cards are on different colored papers because there will be different areas such as:

Blue (chores): Bank Post Bibliothek Kiosk Apotheke Bahnhof

Green (eating):

Restaurant Café Kneipe Heurige Imbissstube Konditorei

Red (shopping):

Markt
Bekleidungsgeschäft
Supermarkt
Bäckerei
Metzgerei
Schmuckladen

Yellow (leisure):

Museum Park Kirche Platz Rathaus Schloß There are bus stops between the blue, green, red and yellow areas. There will be a German speaker at the bus stop who asks each person waiting for the bus:

- Wohin bist du gefahren?
- · Was hast du da gemacht?
- Wohin wirst du fahren?
- Was wirst du dort machen?

If we only do 3 places, then the last (or 4th) place is going home. That means I need at least 4 German speakers.

Then the student takes a bus/streetcar to the next stop. All the while students can get extra points if they have good conversations with each other. They could ask, for example, where the bank is and give directions.

As a conversation piece for students, can I somehow get a poster that shows the streetcar schedule? Then they can chat about the next streetcar.

For fun, I could possibly have another student/parent/colleague go from stop to stop with a cardboard cutout of a streetcar. That person can occasionally stop and yell "Fahrkarten, bitte!" and students should show their tickets. Tickets need to be time stamped somehow.

Needed items:

Errand cards printed on 4 colors

- 4 cameras/tripods
- 4 Haltestelle signs
- 4 Time schedule posters

Simple labels of each place.

Optional:

Items for each place, such as Torten, Geld, Kaffee, etc. Fahrkarten
Time stamp
Streetcar cutout.
